Gloucestershire Outreach Service

This is an outline of the new Gloucestershire Outreach service run by St Mungo's Broadway and commissioned by the six Gloucestershire local authorities: Gloucester, Cheltenham, Tewkesbury, Cotswolds, Forest of Dean and Stroud.

St Mungo's Broadway is a homelessness charity focused on supporting homeless clients and people who are vulnerably housed. We run **outreach** contracts across London and the UK as well as the **No Second Night Out** (NSNO) hubs and a range of housing projects for homeless and vulnerable individuals.

We believe that **no one should live on the streets** and that people can – and do – recover from the issues that create homelessness.

St Mungo's Broadway Gloucestershire Outreach team will help rough sleepers off of the streets by providing support and advice, with partners on a range of issues including healthcare, drug and alcohol treatment, reconnections, community support and housing.

Rough sleeping is dangerous and unhealthy, so we work to ensure clients come off the streets as quickly as possible.

Once off the streets, we help clients to sustain their recovery, enjoying safe and secure accommodation and access to better health, work and training.

Street shifts: We use shifts to verify new people on the streets working in the morning or late at night to best engage rough sleepers.

Drop ins: We are looking to establish surgeries across the county to ensure we give clients easy access to advice, guidance and follow up work.

Multi agency working: We are a small team. We are reliant on developing effective working partnerships with other agencies across housing, health, criminal justice, migrant and substance use areas of work, working to multi-agency action plans.
