Meeting of 17th June 2024

Response submitted regarding consultation on application for a Pavement Licence - Daikoku Ramen, 14 High Street, Stroud

- There must be sufficient room for a vehicle to safely move between the extended area into the street and the area opposite. We would like to see details of the amount of space required and the plans for any demarcation between the seating and the pavement. Without this information it is difficult to comment.
- We understand that solid barriers around the area are better for people with visual impairment than simply a rope

Premises: Daikoku Ramen, 14 High Street, Stroud, Gloucestershire, GL5 1AZ **Proposal**: 3 tables, each with 4 chairs, at front of premises in an area 340cm x 180 cm Two proposed table types

- Long tables 177cm x 50 cm with benches either side
- Square tables 60 cm x 60 cm with four chairs per table

Friday and Saturday - 12.00 to 21:30

Decision

Taking account of comments raised during the consultation period, further discussions with consultees and the applicant, and Stroud District Council's Pavement Policy, I have made a decision to:

Grant the application for:

- Three tables and three chairs per table tables to be no bigger than 60cm x 60 cm
- Pavement licence area to be an area outside the front of to allow a distance of 1 meter between the edge of the chairs and tables and the edge of the kerb demarkation. See attached plan.

The permitted timings are Monday to Thursday – 12:00 to 21:00 Friday and Saturday – 12.00 to 21:30 Sunday – 12.00 to 17.00

• The table and chairs to removed outside of the permitted timings.
