TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (TREE PRESERVATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

STROUD DISTRICT COUNCIL TREE PRESERVATION ORDER NO TPO/0602

Liss Coed, Stratford Road, Stroud, Gloucestershire 2024

The Stroud District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 make the following Order-

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as TPO Number TPO/0602 Liss Coed, Stratford Road, Stroud, Gloucestershire, 2024.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) In this Order "the authority" means Stroud District Council.
- (2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

- 3. (1) Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.
- (2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall-
 - (a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage, or wilfully destroy; or
 - (b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in the Schedule to this Order except with the written consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17, or of the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23, and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.



Application to trees to be planted pursuant to a condition

4. In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the letter "C", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.





Dear Sir or Madam,

You are receiving this email as you previously responded to the contents of the Draft Stroud District Local Plan during the Regulation 19 period of public consultation between May and July 2021.

Background

In October 2021, Stroud District Council submitted the draft Local Plan to the Planning Inspectorate for Examination. Hearing sessions commenced in March 2023 and were paused in June 2023 to allow a summer break. The majority of the hearing sessions have already been held and have covered all strategic and local site allocations and most of the policies set out in the draft Local Plan. Details of the Examination are available on the Local Plan Examination webpage. Please also see the Examination Library.

During 2024, the Council has been working with partners and site promoters to address soundness concerns raised by the Inspectors in their letter dated <u>4 August 2023</u>, ID-010 in the Examination Library. The outcomes of this additional work are available to <u>view</u> and are the subject of this consultation.

Who can respond?

In their letter dated <u>5 February 2024</u>, ID-015 in the Examination Library, the Inspectors requested a six week period of public consultation on the outcomes of the workstreams be carried out. In the same letter, the Inspectors stated that only parties who submitted duly made representations at the Regulation 19 consultation stage of the Plan are invited and eligible to respond.

How to respond

If you wish to comment on the contents of these additional documents, please use the dedicated online response form on the dedicated <u>webpage</u>.

Comments should be limited to the contents of these additional documents ONLY. Other comments will not be accepted.

The consultation will run for six weeks from **Monday 9 September 2024** until **5pm** on **Wednesday 23 October 2024**. Only comments received during this period will be considered.
