


Please be advised of the following closure: Butterrow Hill, Stroud


Please be advised of the following closure: Churchfield Road, Stroud

Dear Local Stakeholder,

The Western Gateway is one of seven sub-national transport bodies in England. Western Gateway STB work with nine constituent Local Authorities, including Gloucestershire, to take a strategic overview of transport, helping to champion and protect the region, prioritise strategic transport interventions, and work cooperatively beyond local boundaries on regional transport issues. Western Gateway's Strategic Transport Plan is the link between national policy and local strategy. The plan focuses on strategic issues relevant to the region. It is supported by the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) – the purpose is to achieve the aims and objectives of the adopted Strategic Transport Plan and to provide a list of prioritised investment proposals for the region.

We are sharing the engagement sessions coming up in December 2024 and January 2025 for the SIP. Please see the details below. Public consultation on the draft Strategic Investment Plan goes live from 20th December 2024 to 2nd February 2025. Consultation draft Private Sector Housing Renewal Policy 2025-30

Article 3 of the Regulatory Reform (Housing Assistance) (England and Wales) Order 2002 places a duty on the Council to adopt and Publish a Private Sector Housing Renewal Policy which details any assistance for housing renewal in the private sector it intends to provide. This includes assistance for homeowners and tenants living in the private rented sector and social housing but, not those in Council owned housing. The policy was last reviewed in 2018 and this current review has taken into account the results of a recent Stock Condition survey and legislative changes that have occurred. Current interventions to improve housing that make a positive difference to public health and reduce health inequalities are explained. A brief overview of relevant national policy demonstrates why housing must sit on the public health agenda and the condition of private sector housing within the district is set out. Finally, details on policy implementation are provided and potential sources of assistance, both financial and non-financial are given. The policy will help in targeting where the Council's limited resources will be directed to address the most need.

The Council are now seeking to consult on the draft revised policy.
