Description

Five bay, three storey building in brick and stone, projecting bay at first floor, Dutch gable with window at second floor, balustrade. "Fine symmetrical stone Baroque façade of 1896-7 by G.M Silley" (Verey and Brooks, 2002, p.660). Original sash windows to first and second storeys. Elegantly built as a "you can trust us" type of Victorian building. Courtyard to centre of building.
