### Description

A well-proportioned 19<sup>th</sup>-century brick and render building on three floors, with stone quoins and string courses. The curved sash windows have keystones over the windows and doors.

The windows and doors appear to be original.

This large house, now a hotel, is situated at the end of a row of brick terraces along London Road, and stands at the east entrance to the town.

Age

Victorian

Architectural and aesthetic value

Large Victorian building at the entrance to the town (when arriving from Cirencester/London)

Degree of completeness

The windows and doors seem to be original.
